- 15,802 power outages statewide. Decrease of 13,000+
- 1,335 Boil Water notices statewide, 54 water systems are no operations (515 Boil Water notices have been rescinded)
- Bottled Water and potable water, shelf stable meals, money
- Plumbers need water heaters
- Governor Abbots office needs plumbers
- Please ask people to complete the TIART (Texas Impact Assessment Recording Tool), 19,544 have been completed (18,667 are for private residences) more owners than renters have reported.
- A little over 2,000 report their home has major damage and they can't stay there; 3,000+ have no insurance
- 14,011 say they had frozen pipes, unmet needs are mostly around the plumbing area

## FEMA REGION 6 | Karla Morgan

- 15,207 registrations by COB yesterday, 32,837 that is coming in per day
- Will they be willing to relocated while their home is being repaired, they can be awarded rental assistance until their home can be repaired.
- Housing Assistance and ONA have a combined fund distributed
- 16,933 outstanding needs
- Partners with TX VOAD, ONE STAR on how you can assist your residents because there will not be a DRC set up
- They can apply by phone at 800-621-3362 or <a href="www.disasterassistance.gov">www.disasterassistance.gov</a> (They have to upload documents here, if they can't upload documents anytime or they can fax documents in and make sure they have registration number on every document)
- They may be able to cover things that insurance cannot cover
- If they get a denial letter, please follow up. There are a lot of reasons why they may be denied
- They need to call 800-621-3362 and find out why they got denied as FEMA is only a piece of the puzzle.
- Appeals: Every resident have a right to appeal their denial, they need to write a statement, supply documentation of why they are appealing.

- This is not a flood event, and make sure they are putting WINTER STORM as their event, and then they can put a
   – flooding.
- If they apply on a mobile device, they may have an error message and tell them to go ahead and call 1-800-621-3362 # to finish applying with FEMA.
- They should be able to use same email from prior disaster, but there has been reporting of people running into that issue.
- Clients can give verbal consent for services providers to call into FEMA on their behalf to release information as needed.
